

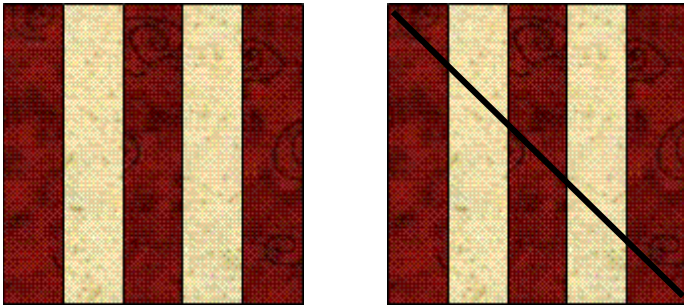
# Spiderweb Quilt

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- Although these diagrams are shown in two colors, my blocks are scrappy and use a variety of light and dark strips.
- I used leftover strips from another project that were cut 1.75 inches so my A & B blocks were 6.5 inches. You can use any size strips but you'll need to do the math!
- I suggest you make a test block first which will take 2 of Block A and 2 of Block B.
- Press seams to the dark strip.

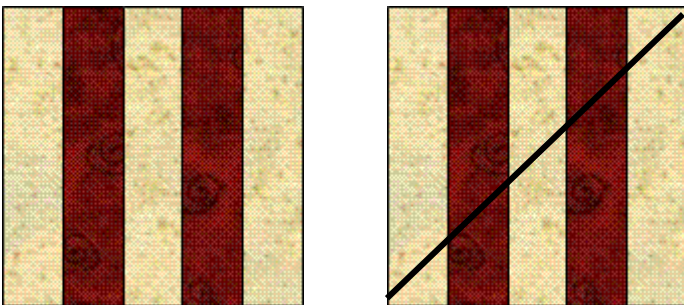
## Block A

Make 24 blocks and cut in half on the diagonal from top left to bottom right



## Block B

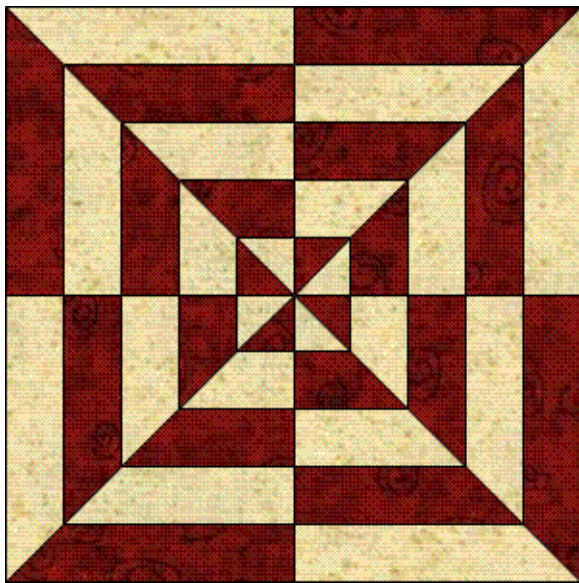
Make 24 blocks and cut in half on the diagonal from bottom left to top right



Sew Block A half to Block B half



Assemble 4 sections as shown below and square up (my blocks squared up to 11.5 inches)



Set blocks 3 x 4

Cut sashing 3 inches (I plan on using pinwheel cornerstones)

Cut inner border 3 inches

Cut outer border 6 inches

Finished quilt is 55x68
