BLOCK SIZE 16 INCHES (16.5 INCHES WITH SEAM ALLOWANCES)



QUILT NOTES:

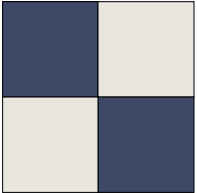
1. I will use the Accuquilt GO to cut out my quilt. The Dies used are the 2.5 inch strip die and the 4.5 inch half square triangle.

PIECING BLOCKS – MAKE 20 BLOCKS

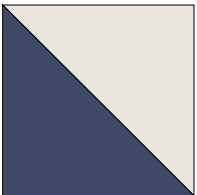
For each 16 inch block (16.5 with seam allowance) you will need the following components.

YOU WILL NEED TO THINK CAREFULLY ABOUT YOUR PRESSING IN ORDER TO HAVE YOUR SEAMS NESTLE TOGETHER NICELY!
PLEASE STUDY THE BLOCK BELOW AND PLAN ACCORDINGLY **BEFORE** STARTING TO MAKE YOUR 4 PATCHES AND HALF
SQUARE TRIANGLES!

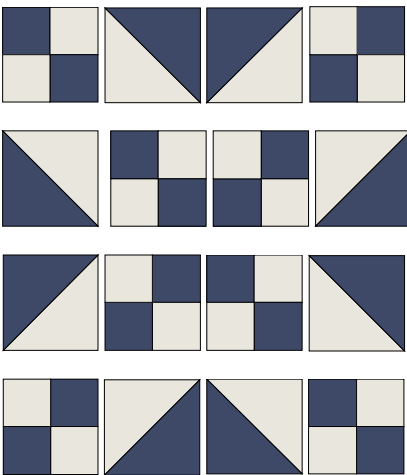
(8) Four Patch blocks pieced from 2.5 inch strips. I use short strips sets to keep it scrappy.



(8) Half square triangles that are 4.5 inches with seam allowances. Use whatever method you prefer.



Assemble the components as shown below, continue to pay close attention to your pressing in order to have the seams nestle.



ASSEMBLING THE TOP

Lay out your 20 blocks 4 across and 5 rows down referring to the drawing on the first page of these instructions as needed.
