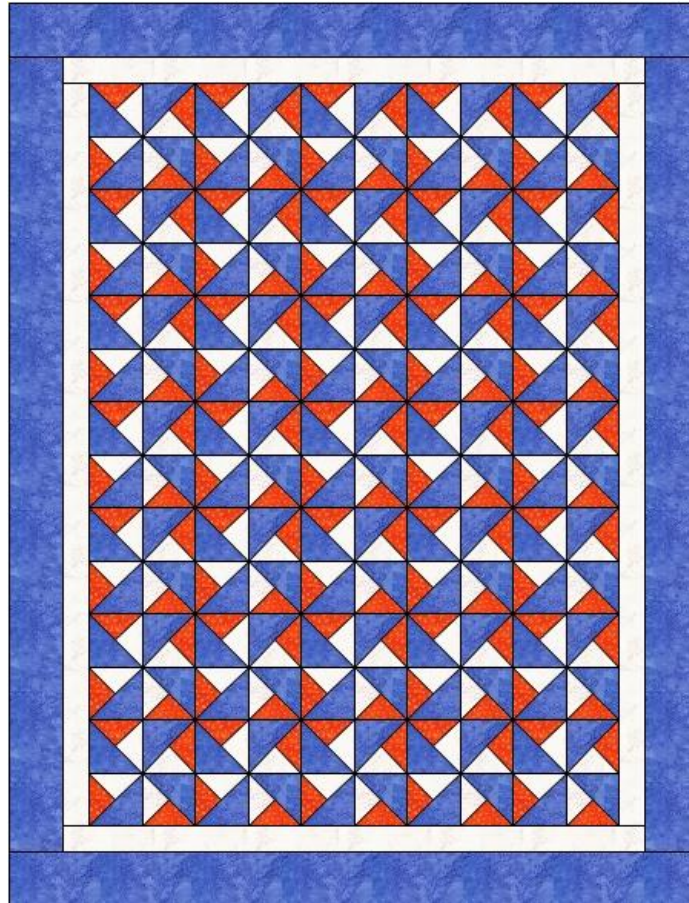


TESSELLATING PINWHEELS

QUILT SIZE 52X68

BLOCKS SET 5 x 7

BLOCK SIZE 8 INCHES (8.5 INCHES WITH SEAM ALLOWANCES)

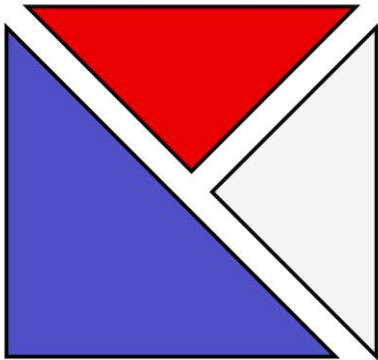


QUILT NOTES:

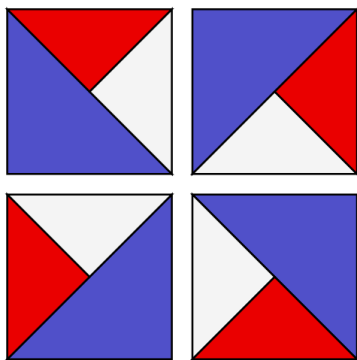
- The above quilt is drawn in 3 colors but I will use many reds/blues/whites for mine including shades of tan and beige.
- Typically I iron my seam allowances to the dark but with this quilt I will iron them open to decrease bulk.
- I'm using my Accuquilt GO cutter for my quilt and am using the 4.5 inch half square triangle and the 4.5 inch quarter square triangle dies to piece my blocks.

PIECING BLOCKS

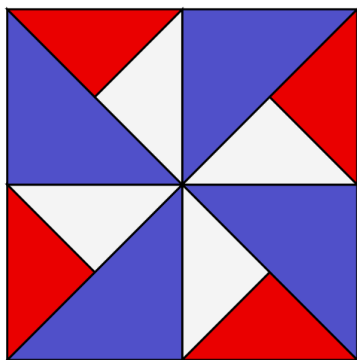
Each Tessellating Pinwheel block is made up of 4 smaller sections. Make sure you place your fabrics in the positions shown below.



Assemble 4 sections – watching how you rotate each block.



YOU WILL NEED 35 BLOCKS



Assemble the top using the drawing on page one of these instructions for reference.

BORDERS

Inner border white border is cut 2.5 inches

Outer blue border is cut 4.5 inches

FABRIC ESTIMATES

I normally do not provide fabric estimates because my quilts are scrappy and I just keep pulling fabric off my shelves until I am done piecing the quilt. The estimates below are from EQ7 **and HAVE NOT BEEN TESTED** and I assume **NO** responsibility for their accuracy!

If you are cutting with GO dies, I suggest you have extra fabric on hand. If you are rotary cutting, I find EQ tends to be generous with its estimates.

For blocks:

3/4 yard of Red

3/4 yard of White

1 and 3/8 yards of Blue

For the border, EQ assumes you are piecing them

5/8 yard of White for inner border

1 and 1/4 yards of Blue for outer border

I typically add a 1/2 yard of fabric for my binding.
