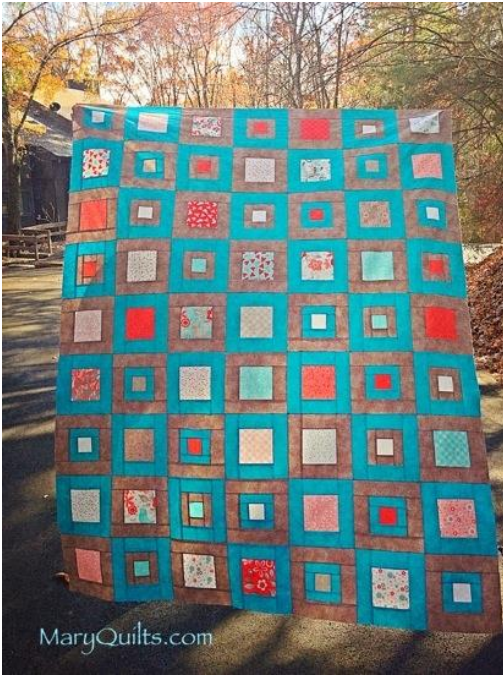


Charmed Squares

Block size is 8.5 inches (9 inches with seam allowances)

Setting is 7 x 9 blocks

Quilt size is 59.5 x 76.5



I used one Charm Pack, 2 yards of brown and 2.5 yards of blue – yardage for blue includes binding.
CAUTION I was VERY careful about cutting and had very little fabric left over. If I was making this quilt again, I'd increase my yardage to 2.5 yards of the brown and 3 yards of the blue and toss any leftovers into the stash.

My quilt takes 63 blocks. I was fairly random when I was framing my blocks and yours does not have to be exactly like mine but the instructions below will show you what I did.

CAUTION: if you have directional prints pay attention to how you are orienting the centers in the framing rounds – you will be rotating all blue framed blocks as you assemble the top.

32 blocks are framed in brown

* 14 of these are double framed ... First in blue and then in the brown

31 blocks are framed in blue

* 13 of these are double framed ... First in the brown and then in the blue.

From my Charm Pack, I took out 7 squares that were solids and cut each of them into 4ths — leaving me with 28 squares that are cut 2.5 inches. I used 27 of these squares in my quilt.

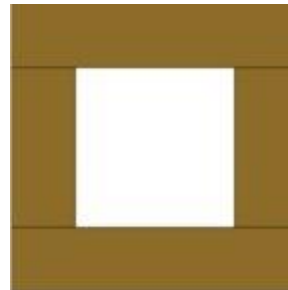
Block A – make 18

Center is a 5 inch Charm Square

From Brown fabric

Cut (2) 2.5 inch by 5 inch pieces and attach to sides of charm square

Cut (2) 2.5 inch by 9 inch pieces and attach to top and bottom of the block



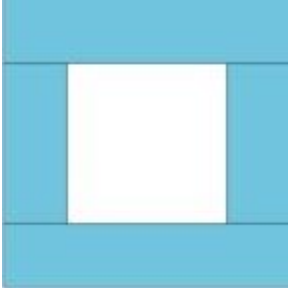
Block B – make 18

Center is a 5 inch Charm Square

From Blue fabric

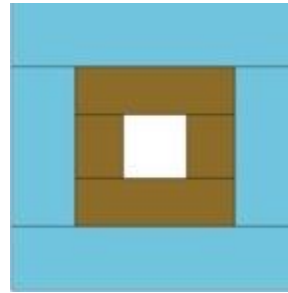
Cut (2) 2.5 inch by 5 inch pieces and attach to sides of charm square

Cut (2) 2.5 inch by 9 inch pieces and attach to top and bottom of the block



of framed square

Cut (2) 2.5 inch by 9 inch pieces and attach to top and bottom of the block



Block C – make 14

Center is a 2.5 inch square (one of the squares cut from your Charm Squares)

From Blue fabric

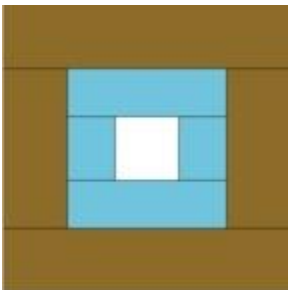
Cut (2) 1.75 x 2.5 inch pieces and attach to sides of center square

Cut (2) 1.75 x 5 inch pieces and attach to top and bottom of block

From Brown fabric

Cut (2) 2.5 inch by 5 inch pieces and attach to sides of framed square

Cut (2) 2.5 inch by 9 inch pieces and attach to top and bottom of the block



**When laying out the blocks, If you turn all the brown blocks with the long seam horizontally and the blue blocks with the long seam vertically, you will not have to match seams. See drawing below of the first two rows of my quilt.

To assemble alternate a brown framed block with a blue framed block and press toward the blue.

Randomly scatter the double framed blocks throughout the quilt. Set blocks 7 across and 9 down starting with a brown block.



Block D – make 13

Center is a 2.5 inch square (one of the squares cut from your Charm Squares)

From Brown fabric

Cut (2) 1.75 x 2.5 inch pieces and attach to sides of center square

Cut (2) 1.75 x 5 inch pieces and attach to top and bottom of block

From Blue fabric

Cut (2) 2.5 inch by 5 inch pieces and attach to sides
